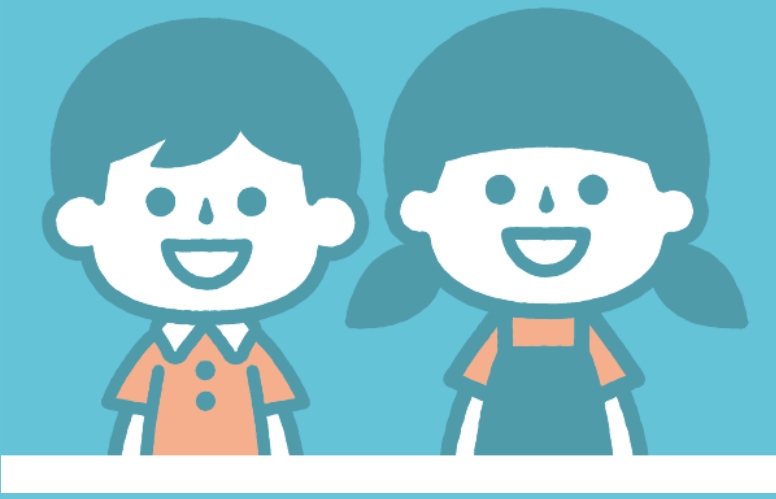


Guide to Inpatient Life for Children

This is a guide to inpatient life at TeunTeun Children's Hospital. We will do our best for the speedy recovery and well-being of our patients.



Admission Guidelines

- Due to the nature of the Pediatrics Department, one resident guardian must be present during hospitalization, and only one guardian is allowed. (If necessary, guardian changes are possible but must be conducted as a direct swap.)
- Please manage your personal belongings carefully within the hospital. (The hospital is not responsible for lost or stolen personal items.)
 - Please do not leave cash or valuables in the patient room, and never place valuables such as wallets on the IV pole.
- Strollers are not permitted.
- Please refrain from noisy activities after 10 PM and observe basic etiquette.
- Please do not ride on the IV pole. There is a risk of injury.
- Please pay special attention to the prevention of burns, falls, and fires.
 - In case of fire, please notify the nursing station immediately and follow the nurse's instructions to evacuate via the designated escape route.
 - Alcohol and smoking are prohibited inside the hospital, and the use of electric cooking appliances is forbidden.
 - Fall Prevention: Please sleep with the bed safety rail (side rail) raised.
 - Please be especially careful not to run in patient rooms and corridors, as there is a risk of falling and injury.
- To prevent patient infection, please receive delivered food and packages outside the door.
- Going out or staying overnight during the hospitalization period is strictly prohibited.
- Please individually seal diapers in disposable bags you have brought and dispose of them in the designated diaper trash can.
- Discharge procedures must be completed before 12 PM. (50% of the room charge will be applied after 12 PM, and 100% after 6 PM.)
- Room changes are not possible on the same day. (Room transfers are permitted only once during the hospitalization period.)
 - Single Room → Single Room (X) / Single Room → Multi-bed Room (O): Room changes are possible from the day after admission, but changing to the same type of room is not possible.
- We do not obtain separate consent forms for the use of non-covered medications and treatment materials required for treatment.

Facilities and Parking

- A water purifier, bottle sterilizer, and microwave are available in the pantry on the ward.
- In each patient room, a refrigerator, telephone, and storage cabinet are individually provided for your use.
- Parking Coupons: During your admission period, a 2-hour coupon can be used twice. On the day of discharge, a 2-hour parking coupon can be used once.
 - (The rest is at your own expense / For all-day passes, please inquire at the management office in the underground parking lot.)
- ※ We are not responsible for lost parking coupons, and parking registration is only possible during outpatient clinic hours.
- Shared Shower Rooms: In front of Room 310 / In front of Room 323.
- Shared Restrooms: In front of Room 316 / In front of Room 324.
- Meal Cart Location: Between Room 315 and Room 316 / Next to Room 340.

Meal Information During Hospitalization

- Meal Service Times: Breakfast 07:30-08:00, Lunch 12:00-12:30, Dinner 17:00-17:30 (Meal Application Deadlines: Breakfast 4:00 / Lunch 11:00 / Dinner 16:00).
- For children under 6 months old, only guardian meals (8,000 KRW incurred separately) can be requested.
- When patient (pediatric) meals are served, cutlery is not provided.
- Other dishes and utensils, please place them on the meal cart at the ward entrance immediately after your meal.
- When using the bottle sterilizer, please be sure to write down (Room Number / Name / Start Time of Use).
- Guardian Meal: Non-covered 8,000 KRW / Patient Meal: Approximately 5,000-7,000 KRW, calculated after health insurance application.

Important Information

- Rounds and Consultation: Rounds are conducted in the morning (08:30-09:00) and in the afternoon (16:00-18:00). There are no rounds on the attending physician's day off. If you need a consultation or wish to be discharged, please request it at the nursing station, and we will connect you to the outpatient clinic on the same day.
- Visiting Guidelines: Visits are permitted twice daily (12:00-13:00, 17:00-18:00). Visitors at risk of infection (individuals with illnesses, the elderly, children under 12) and group visits of 3 or more people are restricted.
- Privacy Protection: If you wish to limit information disclosure, please apply at the admission desk or the 5th-floor administrative office, and your privacy will be thoroughly protected within the designated scope until a separate request for release is made.
- Document Issuance: When issuing certificates, an ID card and supporting documents are required. For detailed application procedures and required documents, please refer to the 'Inpatient Life Guidebook' provided in your room.

In case of an emergency or if you have any questions, dial extension 300# and you will be connected to the nursing station.

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Items to Prepare for Admission

- It is recommended to prepare the following for admission.
- For personal items you bring, please attach a name tag for easy identification to prevent mixing or loss.

Items to Bring.	Provided Items.
Formula, baby bottle, medicine spoon, water bottle, cup, wet wipes Handkerchief, bib, child's spoon and chopsticks Clothes, socks, diapers, comfortable shoes Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, shampoo, lotion, towel, slippers Familiar bedding for your child (One set of bedding and one pillow are provided upon admission) Quiet toys, storybooks Guardian Spoon and chopsticks, bedding, personal toiletries, phone charger Other items: thermometer, scissors & paring knife *Spoon and chopsticks are provided upon request for guardian's meals	One roll of toilet paper, patient gown Patient's bedding, guardian's spoon and chopsticks *Child's spoon and chopsticks are not provided *Guardian's bedding is not provided

If your child is currently taking any medication, please inform the attending physician in advance and bring the prescription and medication. We will review this information and provide consultation based on the attending physician's prescription.
